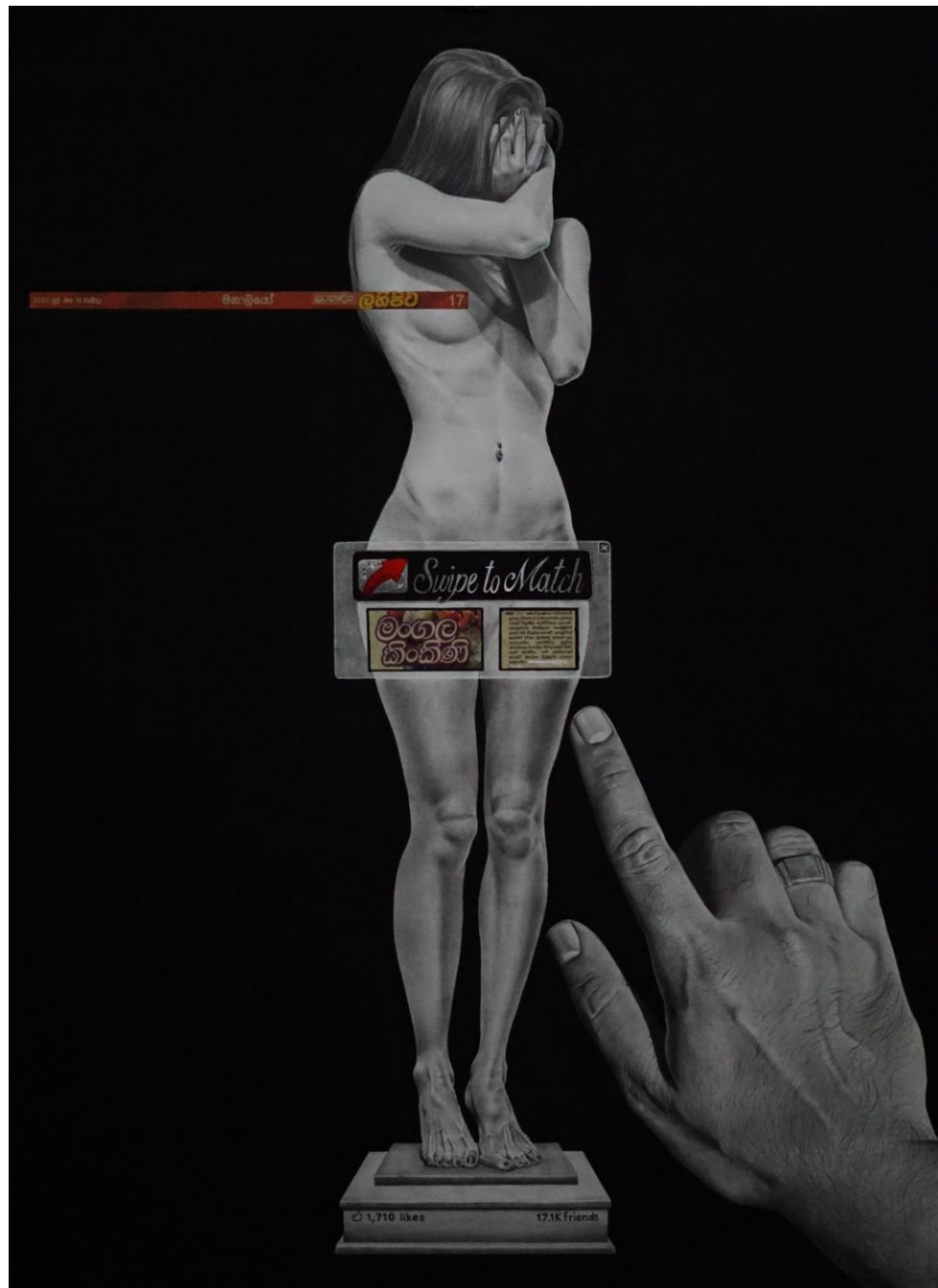

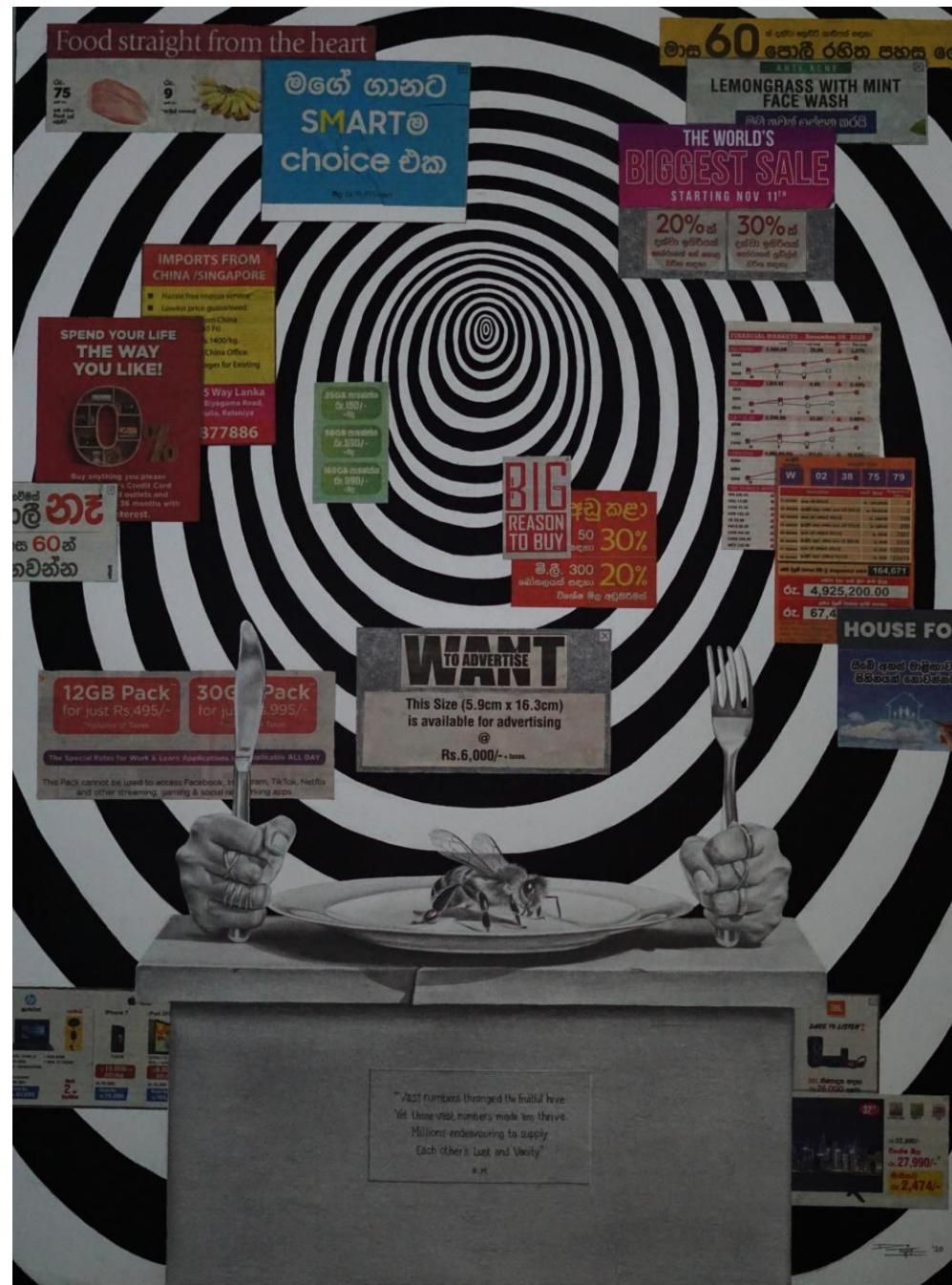

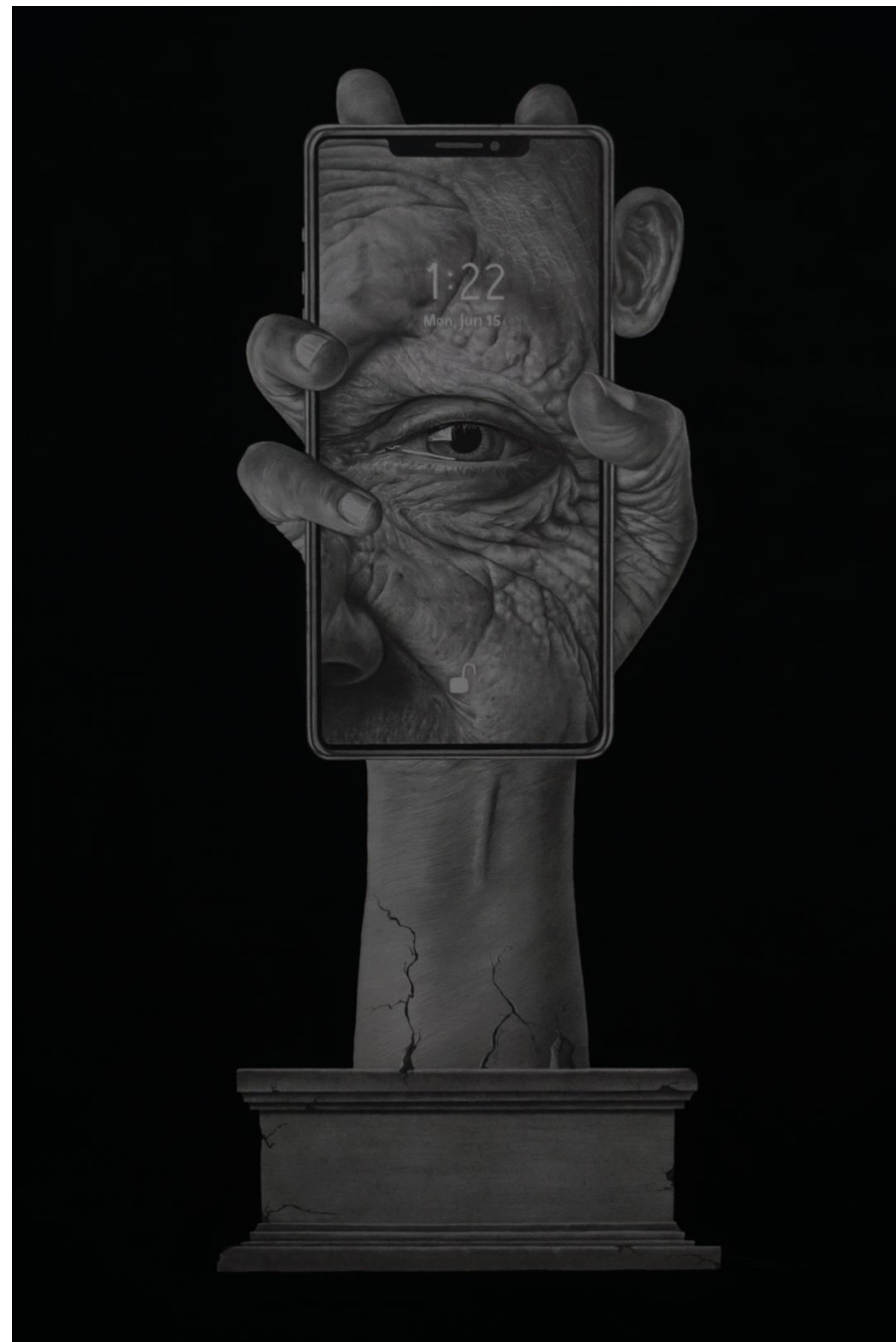
Fable of the Bees

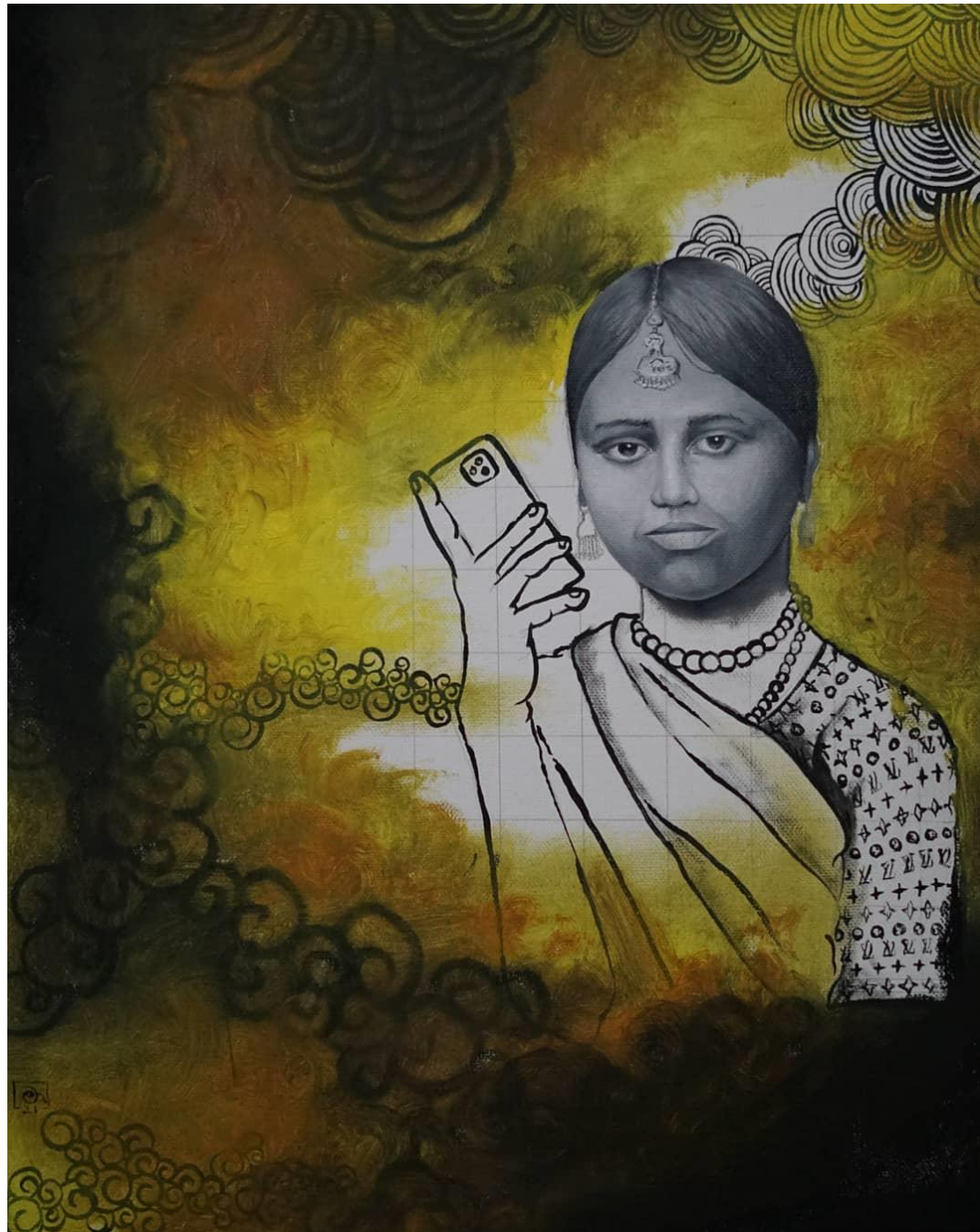
Squares of Chaos: VXC6SA

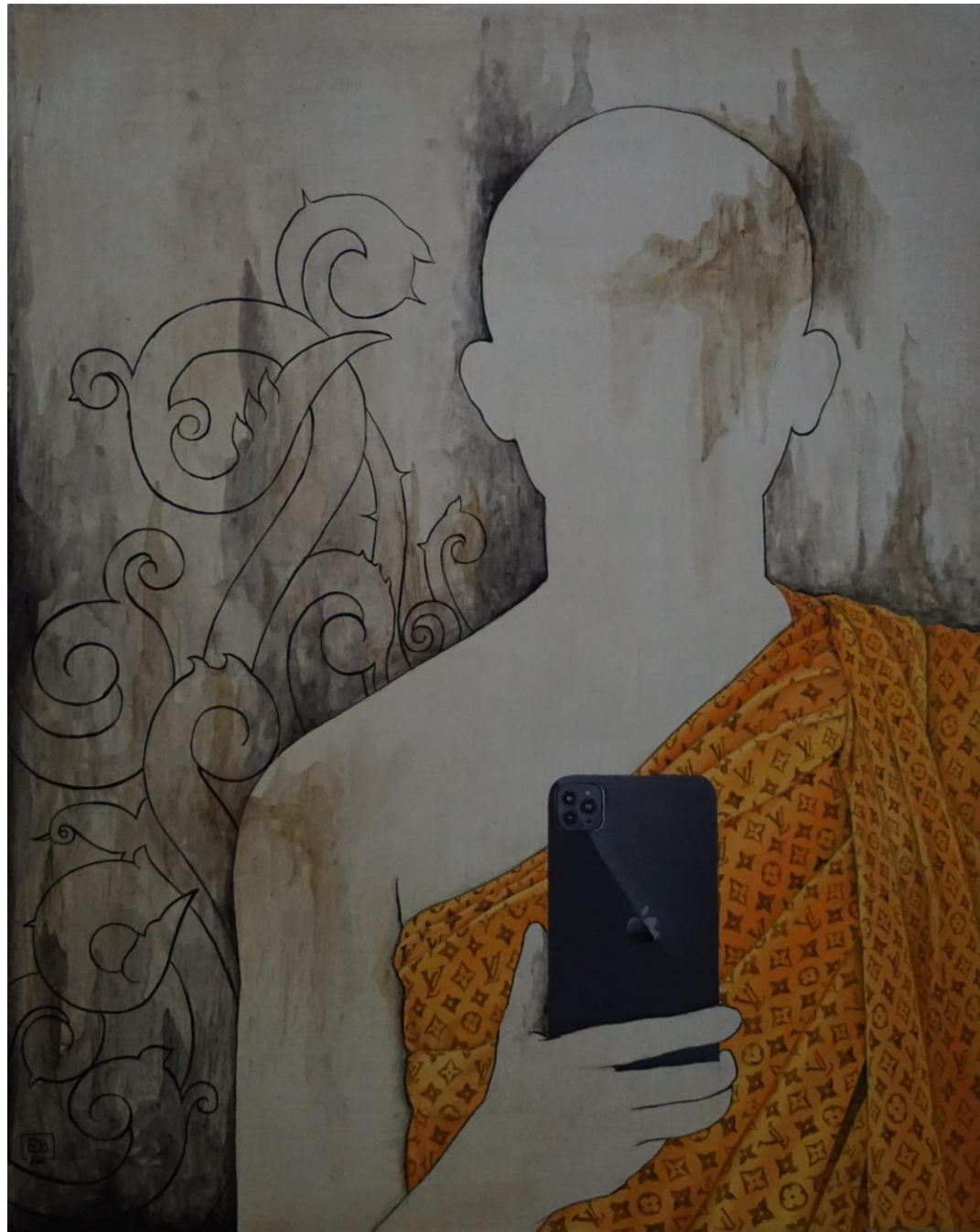

Artist Bio

Malinda Jayasinghe (b. 1992) is a self-taught visual artist who began his career in 2019. Jayasinghe's art practice combines drawing, painting, and sculpting - primarily using ink, paint, wood, cement and glass. He began to fuse his interest in socio-political currents and identity after he completed an Art History course at Theertha International Artists Collective. In his current practice, he uses the visual arts as a platform to explore religious, racial and gender privilege in institutions of power. In 2023, Jayasinghe completed a residency at Colomboscope and held his debut solo exhibition at the Harrold Peiris Gallery. Since then, he has participated in group exhibitions at Saskia Fernando Gallery and Barefoot Gallery.
